Mrs. Gail Corey, Principal of St. Mary School, announces the opening day for the 2010 – 2011 school year will be on Wednesday, September 8th.

Grades 1-8: The first three days of school, Wednesday, September 8th, Thursday, September 9th and Friday, September 10th will be half session days. The school day begins at 7:55 am and ends at 12 noon. There will be no lunch served on these days.

The first full day of school will be Monday, September 13th. School begins at 7:55 am and ends at 2:30 pm.

Kindergarten: Open house with parents on Wednesday, September 8th. Stop in anytime between 8:30 and 10:30 am. The first class day of school for the kindergarten will be on Thursday, September 9th.

Thursday, September 9th and Friday, September 10th will be half session days. The school day begins at 7:55 am and ends at 11:55 am. There will be no lunch served on these days.

The first full day of school for Kindergarten will be on Monday, September 13th. School begins at 7:55 am and ends at 2:25 pm.

Preschool: Preschool will start on Monday, September 13th for our 4-year-old program. Preschool will start on Tuesday, September 14th for our 3-year-old program. Our hours are 8:15 am to 10:45 AM for students attending half-day sessions. Our full-day students in preschool start at 8:15 am and end at 2:15 pm.

ATTENTION PARENTS/GUARDIANS
CAP PHASE 1 & 2 SESSIONS

The CAP I (Child Assault Prevention Program) teaches attendees to recognize child abuse and neglect and how to report to the proper authorities. Adults are taught that children have the right to be safe, strong and free. **CAP 1** is for new volunteers and employees. **CAP 2** (No More Bullies, No More Victims). A workshop on bullying awareness and bullying prevention. Cyberbullying is also addressed. Both sessions are 90 minutes.

The Diocese of Camden requires anyone in regular contact with children to attend at least one of the sessions. Diocesan Policy requires adults to attend CAP 1 once every five years. Adults must attend CAP 1 before attending CAP 2.
